Richard Price is the Fire Chief for the San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District. Price was appointed to the position on July 25, 2008. Price also serves as the Treasurer of the District. Prior to his appointment he served for two years as an Assistant Fire Chief with the District. Price joined the District after serving twenty-seven years in San Mateo County and today has more than thirty years of career fire service experience.

Price holds a Master's Degree in Public Administration (MPA) from California State University Hayward. He is a California State Certified Fire Chief and is an internationally certified Chief Fire Officer ([CFO](#)). In 2009 Price completed the four-year Executive Fire Officer ([EFO](#)) Program at the National Fire Academy in Maryland and is a graduate of the Harvard University Senior Executives in State and Local Government Program at the Kennedy School of Government. Price is also a Certified Special District Administrator ([SDA](#)). Price is currently attending the Center for Homeland Defense and Security (CHDS) Executive Leaders Program at the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, CA.

Price is President of [Leadership San Ramon Valley](#) and is a board member of the [One Hundred Club of Contra Costa County](#). Price is also a member of the Exchange Club of San Ramon Valley. Price is Past President of the Contra Costa County Fire Chiefs Association and a past Incident Commander on both the Contra Costa County and East Bay Incident Management Teams. Price holds membership in several professional organizations including the International Association of Fire Chiefs (IAFC), California Fire Chiefs Association (CFCA), International Association of City Managers (ICMA), California Special Districts Association (CSDA) and the Fire Districts Association of California (FDAC).
